Building godly relationships




1 Corinthians 6:19 -20

Memory Theme Verse: Flee immorality. Every other sin that a man commits is outside the body, but the immoral man sins against his own body. Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your

own? For you have been bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body.

A. On a journey

At some point in your life, you will be on a love journey (if you haven't already). That love journey must begin with God.

Trust in the LORD with all your heart and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make your paths straight...Proverbs 3:5-6

B. Finding Love

- i. **Love God** Matthew 22:37 Jesus replied: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind."
- ii. **God is a Match-Maker** Genesis 2:18 *The LORD God said, "It is not good for the man to be alone. I will make a helper suitable for him."*



iii. Patience and Prayer go together: Philippians 4:6-7 Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all comprehension, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

C. Setting the Rules; Creating the Boundaries



It is important that as a Christian you establish clear boundaries in your relationship. Love is not measured by just sex. Love is measured by your willingness to respect and honour one another. Commit to keeping your marriage bed holy. Remember, in establishing boundaries in your relationships, you are honouring God and each other too.

How far should one go in a relationship?

Hebrews 13:4 - Marriage should be honoured by all, and the marriage bed kept pure, for God will judge the adulterer and all the sexually immoral.

Leviticus 11:44 for I am the LORD your God. Consecrate yourselves therefore, and be holy, for I am holy.

D. Keep Watch



- I. The enemy is interested in your sexual purity: 1 Peter 5:8 Be of sober spirit, be on the alert. Your adversary, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour. But resist him, firm in your faith, knowing that the same experiences of suffering are being accomplished by your brethren who are in the world.
- **II. Flee Sexual Immorality** 1 Corinthians 6:18 *Flee from sexual immorality. All other sins a person commits are outside*

the body, but whoever sins sexually, sins against their own body.

- iv. Resist the devil James 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.
- v. **Temptation is normal** 1 Corinthians 10:13: No temptation has overtaken you that is not common to man. God is faithful, and he will not let you be tempted beyond your ability, but with the temptation he will also provide the way of escape, that you may be able to endure it.
- vi. **You are a new Creation in Christ: Live like a Champ** 2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.
