Introduction What does it mean to step out of our comfort zone? It means stepping out of the familiar into the unfamiliar. It means to challenge yourself to the point where as the YWAM'er say, "TRUST GOD OR DIE". Stepping out of our comfort zones should be for all Christians but for all of us challenged to do

so, only a few will actually do it.

These are the familiars in terms of your journey as a Christian. Comfort Zones are things that make you comfortable as a Christian. Maybe you are someone who cannot openly share about your faith or you cannot lift your hands in worship or maybe praying for people
