

## A Pentecost Generation:

Introduction: Stepping into miracles

We are following a series of bible study about the power we receive when the Spirit of the Lord comes upon us. We learn from Acts 2 that those that receive the Holy Spirit are changed. The destinies change, their ministries, their influence and their impact. The bottom line is you cannot receive the Spirit of the Lord and not change. In fact, through His Spirit, you are also stepping out into miracles and that is the focus of our Bible Study today.

### A. Stepping into Miracles

*What does it mean to step into miracles? Is there a special formula out there that decides the kind of miracles we receive when we follow Christ?*

**Read Acts 3: 1-10**

5. How can you describe Peter and Paul on this particular day?
6. What are some key qualities you need to step into your miracles?
7. What did the beggar expect from the disciples that day?
8. What did the disciples say that attracted the miracles?

9. What did the disciples do that attracted the miracles?

10. What miracles happened on this day?

11. What made the beggar get healed that day? – (16)

12. Did the miracles come from the disciples?
